Held at the Harmony campus, these non-credit courses are perfect for those new to computers or looking to strengthen digital literacy. Basic Computer Skills covers essentials like using a mouse and keyboard, opening and saving files, and browsing the internet safely. Internet Basics focuses on navigating the web, using search engines, and understanding online safety. For Spanish-speaking learners, Habilidades de informática básicas provides the same foundational instruction in Spanish, with clear, step-by-step guidance and hands-on practice in a computer lab. New for winter 2026 will be Conceptos básicos de Internet for Spanish speakers. The cost for each class is \$35 and requires no prior experience.
